CASN's mission is to lead nursing education and nursing scholarship in the interest of healthier Canadians.

Founded in 1942, CASN is the national voice for nursing education and nursing research and represents nursing programs in Canada. With 90 member schools, CASN speaks for Canadian nursing education and scholarship. CASN works to establish and promote national standards of excellence for nursing education; promote the advancement of nursing knowledge; facilitate the integration of theory, research, and practice; contribute to public policy; and provide a national forum for issues in nursing education and research.

CASN prides itself on being a bilingual, voluntary, registered charitable organization; representing universities and colleges in Canada that offer part or all of an undergraduate or graduate degree in nursing. 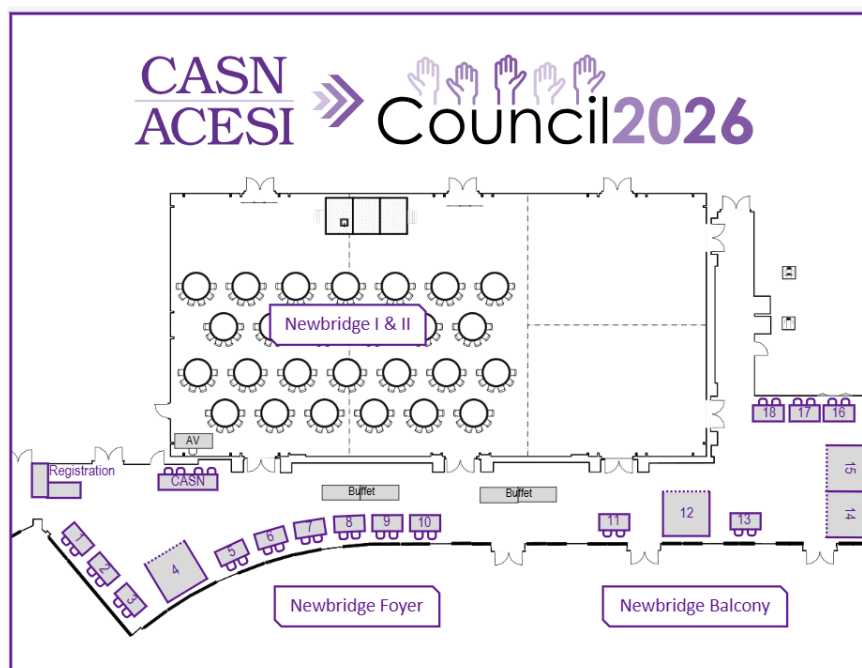
