Position Description

The Ingram School of Nursing of the Faculty of Medicine, McGill University, is seeking applications for a tenure-track position. Candidates with research interests in one or more of the following areas are being sought: (1) elder health/gerontology; (2) mental health; (3) primary care/health services and (4) the health of indigenous populations. This tenure-track position is open for appointment to the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor.

The successful candidate will be joining the School at a stimulating time of growth and energy with a recently enlarged number of education- and research-focused faculty, major curricular revisions, and a new physical space with state-of-the-art teaching and research facilities.

Job Duties

The successful candidate will be expected to develop an independent research program in one of the fields listed above, and to contribute to undergraduate and graduate teaching. The successful incumbent will also be expected to contribute to service activities within the School, the University and the wider scholarly community.

Qualifications and Education Requirements

Candidates will have been trained as nurses with a doctorate in nursing or a related discipline, post-doctoral training, and a track record of peer-reviewed publications. Evidence of success in receiving competitive, external research funding will be an asset for appointment to this position and for eventual promotion in McGill's research-intensive environment. All candidates should be fluent in English and would benefit from a working knowledge of French.
