**(36 Month Regular Term Appointment)**

Memorial University Faculty of Nursing invites applications for a 36-month regular-term teaching position at the rank of Assistant Professor, effective August 1, 2020 [negotiable]. This position is subject to final budgetary approval. The position is for an applicant who is a **Nurse Practitioner** and can teach in our Nurse Practitioner program and BN and MN programs.

Memorial University is the largest university in Atlantic Canada. As the province's only university, Memorial plays an integral role in the education and cultural life of Newfoundland and Labrador. Offering diverse undergraduate and graduate programs to almost 18,000 students, Memorial provides a distinctive and stimulating environment for learning in St. John's, a safe and friendly city with great historic charm, a vibrant cultural life, and easy access to a wide range of outdoor activities.

The Faculty of Nursing is located on the university campus and offers programs leading to the Bachelor of Nursing (4 year option and accelerated option), the Master of Nursing (practicum and Nurse Practitioner options), the Post-Master's Nurse Practitioner Graduate Diploma, and the PhD in Nursing. Position responsibilities include teaching and clinical supervision in the undergraduate and graduate programs. The successful candidate must be eligible for licensure with the Association of Registered Nurses of Newfoundland and Labrador as a Nurse Practitioner and have a master's degree in nursing.

Candidates must be prepared to teach in the undergraduate, graduate and Nurse Practitioner programs and thus must have relevant clinical experience as a Nurse Practitioner and as a Registered Nurse. We are particularly interested in applications from Nurse Practitioners who have a PhD in nursing or who are enrolled in a PhD in Nursing program and/or who can teach statistics and/or quantitative research methods courses.

A complete application is comprised of: (a) letter of introduction outlining relevant clinical and teaching experience, brief description of research program, and statements of teaching philosophy and nursing philosophy; (b) curriculum vitae; and (c) names and contact information for three referees under separate cover to the Dean, Faculty of Nursing.
