

Dr. Jacinthe Pepin – Keynote speaker – Tuesday, May 26/2020

Keynote address title: Learning experiences in complex environments: transforming the nursing practice

Biography:

Jacinthe Pepin, RN, PhD is a full Professor and Director of the *Centre d'innovation en formation infirmière* (CIFi) at the *Université de Montréal's* Faculty of Nursing. She has also been a Visiting Professor at *Dalhousie University's* School of Nursing (2016-2017) and at the *Institut de formation et de recherche en soins* at the *Université de Lausanne* (2008 et 2009). Dr. Pepin is the scientific leader of a multidisciplinary and inter-university research team funded by *the Fonds de recherche du Québec, Société et culture* (FRQSC, 2013-2021), whose research focuses on the learning of health care professionals. She is the Co-Editor in Chief of the Canadian Association of Schools of Nursing's (CASN) scientific journal *Quality Advancement in Nursing Education/ Avancées en formation infirmière*. Dr. Pepin was also the recipient of CASN's 2015 Pat Griffin Scholar Award, for research in nursing education.

Since 2017, Dr. Pepin has chaired the Advisory Council on Nursing Education (le Conseil consultatif sur la formation infirmière) of the *Secrétariat international des infirmières et infirmiers de l'espace francophone* (SIDIEF). As a regular member of the Quebec Network on Nursing Intervention Research's (RRISIQ), she has assumed shared responsibility of its international development platform (2014-2019). Dr. Pepin is co-author of numerous publications, including the books *La pensée infirmière* (4th edition, 2017) and *Les sciences infirmières, genèse d'une discipline* (2002), as well as numerous scientific papers, reports and book chapters. In 2019, she was the recipient of the Florence Award, for international outreach/influence, from the *Ordre des infirmières et infirmières du Québec* (OIIQ).
