

CASN COVID-19 Nurse Educator Knowledge Exchange Series Guidelines for Submissions

Submissions

CASN is requesting submission for webinars to promote the exchange of ideas and information as nurse educators are rapidly modifying and adapting to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Proposed presentation types may include but are not limited to:

- Unique endeavors, initiatives, or innovative approach to address challenges related to COVID-19
- Examining an area of nursing within the context of COVID-19 (e.g., public health, caring for older adults)
- A panel discussion of a timely issues for nurse educators
- Detailed tutorial of new ways of teaching and learning
- An adapted presentation of research that is relevant to the global pandemic and nursing education

Proposed themes or areas to explore include but are not limited to:

- How to ensure high quality education
- Best practices for online and distance learning
- Leadership in education in times of uncertainty
- Virtual simulation and clinical education
- Mental health and resiliency
- Supporting at-risk populations
- Supporting transition to practice into a stressed healthcare system
- Protecting nurses, students, and new grads

CASN will accept written submissions that are a maximum of 300 words in length.

Submission Format

The following format is suggested for your submission:

- Title
- Objectives
- Description of content (background, methods, results)

- Conclusions
- Description of planned format (e.g., panel discussion, inclusion of Q&A, etc.)

Delivery

Please note that CASN uses Adobe Connect and Zoom for webinar delivery. Presentations should be one hour in length, including time for questions. Presenters may secure their own moderator for the webinar. If required, CASN will secure a moderator to assist with the webinar.

Review Process

A CASN Staff member is responsible for collecting all submissions and verifying submissions are complete.

CASN will review the submission to assess that the presentation:

- Aligns with the theme of the presentations
- Is scientifically sound
- Is non-commercial in nature

NOTE: The submission should be rejected if it does not meet these expectations and/or is of poor quality.

Please note that all submissions are considered to be confidential.
