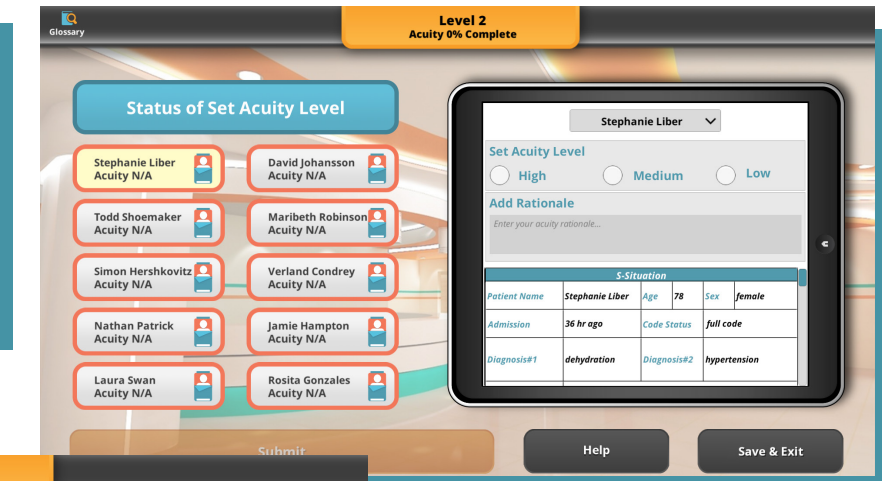

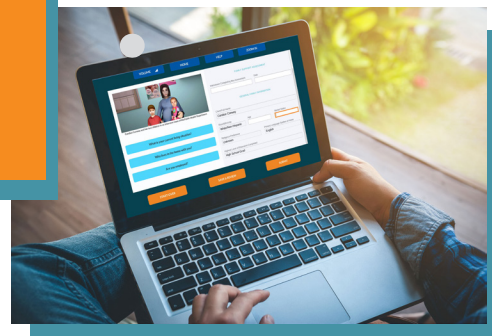

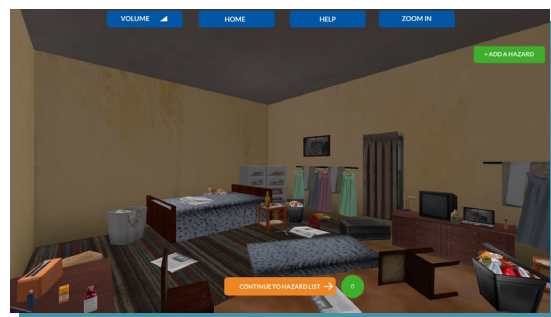
# Virtual Clinical Scenarios
