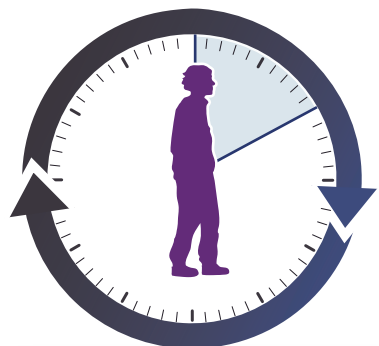

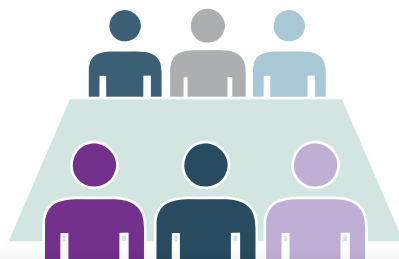
## Nurses, pharmacists, and social workers have a key role to play.

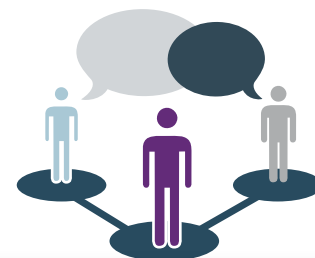
