Position Descriptions

CASN Board of Directors

2021 Elections: 1 Director position - Indigenous Faculty Representative, 2 Director positions in the Western/Northwestern Region, 2 Director positions in the Ontario Region, and 2 Director positions in the Atlantic Region.

Meeting requirements/Commitments:

- In person: Spring: One afternoon or evening working dinner and a full day, in-person meeting (May/June)*;
- In person: Fall: One afternoon or evening working dinner and a full day, in-person meeting (November)*;
- Three or four virtual meetings a year;
- Regular correspondence; and
- Board members act as a liaison to a CASN committee or task force (5-6 virtual meetings/ year).

**These meetings may also be held virtually due to COVID-19.*

Responsibilities of the Directors (from CASN Bylaws):

- Govern the affairs of the Association and are responsible for the policy of the Association.
- Set the annual budget and make expenditures to conduct the business of the Association.
- Delegate and designate by resolution the right to employ and pay salaries to employees.
- Vote as a Board on matters to determine best course of action for issues with respect to policy and governance.
- Term of Office: 2 years (2021-2023).
- *Two-year term, renewable by election twice for a maximum of 3 consecutive terms.*
