## Dr. Jacinthe Pepin – Keynote speaker

**Keynote address title**: Learning experiences in complex environments: transforming the nursing practice

## Biography:

Jacinthe Pepin, RN, PhD is a full Professor and the Faculty of Nursing Secretary at the Université de Montréal. Funding Director of the Centre d'innovation en formation infirmière (CIFI, 2007-2020), she has also been a Visiting Professor at Dalhousie University's School of Nursing (2016-2017) and at the Institut de formation et de recherche en soins at the Université de Lausanne (2008 et 2009). Dr. Pepin is the scientific leader of a multidisciplinary and inter-university research team funded by the Fonds de recherche du Québec, Société et culture (FRQSC, 2013-2021), whose research focuses on the learning of health care professionals. She is Co-Editor-in-Chief of the Canadian Association of Schools of Nursing's (CASN) scientific journal Quality Advancement in Nursing Education/ Avancées en formation infirmière. Since 2017, Dr. Pepin has chaired the Advisory Council on Nursing Education of the Secrétariat international des infirmières et infirmiers de l'espace francophone (SIDIIEF). Dr. Pepin has led international studies and position papers on nursing education and has authored numerous publications, including the book La pensée infirmière (4th edition, 2017). Dr. Pepin was the recipient of CASN's 2015 Pat Griffin Scholar Award, for research in nursing education. In 2019, she was the recipient of the Florence Award, for international outreach/influence, from the Ordre des infirmières et infirmières du Québec (OIIQ).
