QUALIFICATIONS

The successful candidate in a tripartite appointment will teach theory and practice courses in the Nurse Practitioner program within the School of Nursing, will engage in service to the university and community, and will have a developing program of research and scholarship. Preference is for candidates with advanced nursing practice across the lifespan.

- PhD or other doctorate; consideration may be given to doctoral candidates who will complete their degree by the appointment date or shortly thereafter;
- Must have current license as a Nurse Practitioner and be eligible for BCCNM registration in good standing, without limits or conditions;
- Current Three (3) years' experience in the role of a Nurse Practitioner;
- Working knowledge of legislation informing the practice of Nurse Practitioners;
- Excellent communication skills and commitment to interprofessional care;
- Demonstrated ability to work independently and collaboratively as a member of an academic team;
- Excellent health assessment, clinical judgment, analytical, and problem-solving skills;
- Demonstrated ability to respect diversity and use inclusive behavior, responding with sensitivity and self-awareness to the unique needs of graduate students including visible and non-visible dimensions of diversity;
- Prior exposure teaching at a post-secondary educational institution is an asset;
- Experience teaching theory and clinical practice is an asset;
- Experience with simulation learning environments is an asset; and
- Knowledge of online learning management systems is an asset.
