

About the CASN Nursing Education Conference

In 1986, the Canadian Association of Schools of Nursing (CASN) saw a need to showcase nursing education research and began hosting annual national conferences. From 1986 to 2013, CASN's conferences spotlighted one of three areas: research, education, or academic leadership.

In 2014, CASN launched the Canadian Nursing Education Conference, a biennial event that represents all aspects of nursing education and brings researchers, educators, and stakeholders together to discuss the hottest topics and issues facing nursing education today. This conference has long been the hallmark event for top nursing researchers and educators in Canada.

The 2023 conference will focus on the changing and ever-growing world of nursing education. The main theme will be *Anti-discriminatory pedagogy in nursing education*. The conference's program is expected to feature over 250 presentations, including oral presentations, poster presentations, panel/symposia, and PhD students with thesis in progress presentations. As well, two keynote panel addresses will address the theme of the conference each day.


Exhibitor set-up information

Founded in 1942, the Canadian Association of Schools of Nursing (CASN) is the national voice for nursing education and nursing research and represents nursing programs in Canada. With 95 member schools, CASN speaks for Canadian nursing education and scholarship. CASN works to establish and promote national standards of excellence for nursing education; promote the advancement of nursing knowledge; facilitate the integration of theory, research, and practice; contribute to public policy; and provide a national forum for issues in nursing education and research.

CASN prides itself on being a bilingual, voluntary organization; representative of universities and colleges in Canada that offer part or all of an undergraduate or graduate degree in nursing; and a registered charitable organization. CASN maintains relationships with several national nursing, health, and research organizations.

As the national accrediting agency for baccalaureate programs in nursing, CASN is now also accrediting domestic practical nurse diploma programs, internationally educated nurse bridging programs, master's level nurse practitioner programs, as well as international baccalaureate programs leading to the registered nurse designation.

The CASN Council is composed of Deans, Directors, and Chairs of member nursing schools.
