DUTIES

The position may involve teaching theory courses, skills in a laboratory setting and facilitation of learning experiences in both the facility and community clinical settings. In addition to teaching duties, the instructor will be responsible for classroom management, student supervision and advising, maintenance of student records and grades and curriculum review/development and other administrative tasks. Instructors also assist with assigned activities including University College promotion, student recruitment, and various program administrative functions.

- Registered Nurse with an Undergraduate and a Graduate Nursing Degree (preferred)
- An active CRNM membership without restrictions
- A minimum of 5 years of work experience in nursing is essential
