

Canadian Nursing Education Conference 2024 Presentation instructions/information

Registration deadline for presenters: Monday March 4, 2024

Oral presentations	 Presentation length: 15 minutes A total of three presentations will be scheduled per concurrent session. When presentations are completed, there will be 10 minutes for a Q&A session with audience and all three presenters.
Poster presentations	 Posters will be presented during a scheduled poster session. Poster must fit within the provided poster board space (i.e., cannot exceed 8 feet width x 4 feet height). OPTIONAL: Poster presenters may send in a 60 second 'poster-pitch' video, which will be shown on day 1 or day 2 of the conference. Deadline to upload 'poster pitch" video: Tuesday, April 30, 2024, 11:59 p.m. ET (Ontario time) Pre-recorded presentation format: .mp4, .mov, .avi. If recording audio only using PowerPoint or Keynote, file must be exported as a .mp4. Recording instructions/resources: https://impactay.ca/resources/

Panel/symposium presentations	 Presentation length: 45 minutes, followed by 10 minutes for audience engagement/questions. Designed to allow a team of presenters (three or more individuals) to bring a variety of perspectives to a single education topic, initiative, or experience that might not otherwise be possible within a single oral presentation session.
Graduate students with	 Presentation length: 5 minutes Graduate students will present in a short format, using 4-5 slides.
thesis in progress or project	 When all presentations are completed, there will be a moderated discussion with audience and presenters. This will allow for discussion on stuck points, shared progress, dialogue about decision points, engagement in conversation about other learnings and suggestions.
Work in progress with	Presentation length: 6 minutes
facilitated discussion	 In a short format, using 7-8 slides. A total of 4 presentations will be scheduled per concurrent session. When all presentations are completed, there will be a moderated discussion with audience and presenters. This will allow for discussion on stuck points, shared progress, dialogue about decision points, engagement in conversation about other learnings and suggestions.
