



## Presentation instructions/information

Presentation PowerPoint and e-poster PDF files will need to be uploaded prior to the conference. Upload instructions will be provided after the March 19, 2026, presenters registration deadline.

To keep the program running smoothly and ensure every presenter receives their full allotted time, we will be closely managing the schedule. The moderator will provide time cues as you approach your limit and will stop your presentation when time is up so we can transition to the next speaker on time.

<b>Oral presentations (in person)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Presentation length: 15 minutes, including Q&amp;A. Presenters will need to time their presentation to include time for Q&amp;A.</li> <li>• A total of three presentations will be scheduled per concurrent session.</li> </ul>
<b>Poster presentations (in person)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Posters will be presented during a scheduled poster session.</li> <li>• Poster must fit within the provided poster board space (i.e., cannot exceed 8 feet width x 4 feet height).</li> </ul>
<b>E-poster presentations (virtual)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• E-posters will be available to view on the conference platform on demand. Presenters do not have to be available on a certain day/time to answer questions as their contact information will be available.</li> <li>• File format: PDF</li> <li>• Presenters have the option of providing a pre-recorded presentation with their e-poster (5 minutes maximum length).</li> </ul>
<b>Panel/symposia presentations (in person)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Presentation length: 60 minutes including Q&amp;A. Presenters will need to time their presentation to include time for Q&amp;A.</li> <li>• Designed to allow a team of presenters (three or more individuals) to bring a variety of perspectives to a single education topic, initiative, or experience that might not otherwise be possible within a single oral presentation session.</li> </ul>
<b>Students with thesis in progress or project (in person)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Presentation length: 10 minutes – in short format, using 5-8 slides.</li> <li>• A total of three presentations will be scheduled per concurrent session. Presentations will be back to back, with no Q&amp;A after each.</li> <li>• When all presentations are completed, there will be a moderated discussion with audience and presenters. This will allow for discussion on stuck points, shared progress, dialogue about decision points, engagement in conversation about other learnings and suggestions.</li> </ul>
<b>Work in progress (in person)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Presentation length: 10 minutes – in a short format, using 5-8 slides.</li> <li>• A total of three presentations will be scheduled per concurrent session. Presentations will be back to back, with no Q&amp;A after each.</li> <li>• When all presentations are completed, there will be a moderated discussion with audience and presenters. This will allow for discussion on stuck points, shared progress, dialogue about decision points, engagement in conversation about other learnings and suggestions.</li> </ul>
<b>Affinity group session (in person)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Session length: 60 minutes.</li> <li>• These sessions provide an opportunity to network and dialogue with conference participants about a shared topic of interest.</li> </ul>
