

FACULTY OF NURSING 4-8-12 Month Teaching-Term Appointments ST. JOHN'S CAMPUS

Memorial University Faculty of Nursing (MUNFON) is located on the university campus and offers programs leading to a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (four-year and accelerated options), a Master of Science in Nursing (practicum and nurse practitioner options), a Post-Master's Nurse Practitioner Graduate Diploma, and a PhD in Nursing.

The Faculty of Nursing has four, eight, and twelve-month teaching-term appointments for the 2026-2027 academic year. These positions are for clinical teaching in all clinical areas in the BScN program, or for clinical teaching in the MScN Program (Nurse Practitioner option). While these appointments are for clinical teaching, the incumbent may also be required to teach a course or courses in a classroom, laboratory, or online in Brightspace.

The minimum qualifications for teaching-term appointments at the undergraduate level are a completed bachelor's degree (in nursing), and a master's degree, with preference given to applicants with a Master of Nursing or a Master of Science (Nursing) degree. Candidates who are near completion of a master's degree may also be considered. A minimum two years of nursing experience within the past three years in the clinical area of practice is required for clinical teaching in the undergraduate program. The minimum qualification for teaching a clinical course in the nurse practitioner program is three to five years of experience as a Nurse Practitioner.

Please note that successful applicants must hold a current practicing license with the College of Registered Nurses of Newfoundland and Labrador (CRNNL) for the duration of the contract period, provide a criminal records screening and vulnerable sector check, and an up-to-date immunization record.

A complete application is comprised of the following: a letter of introduction outlining relevant clinical and teaching experience, a current curriculum vitae, and the names and contact information (including email addresses) of three references, one of which is the applicant's current supervisor.
