



Information for the Pat Griffin Research Grant – 2026

Purpose

The Canadian Association of Schools of Nursing (CASN) is offering one Pat Griffin Research Grant in 2026 to support research that addresses **Nursing Education Innovation**.

The research can focus on all academic levels of nursing education.

Research Funding

Funds for this grant are provided by the [Dr. Pat L. Griffin Fund of CASN](#).

Grant Details

- Grants available: One per calendar year
- Funding: Up to \$15,000
- Deadline for submission: May 4, 2026, at 12:00 p.m. EDT
- Earliest date that funds will be released: July 2, 2026
- Application language: Either French or English

Eligibility Criteria

- The primary investigator must be faculty at a [CASN member school](#).
- Previous CASN grant recipients (primary investigator or co-investigator) must wait 2 years before being eligible for a subsequent CASN grant.
- The grant recipient must agree to sign a research agreement and provide interim and final reports to the CASN National Office.
- Research must address “Nursing Education Innovation”
- The application is 10 pages maximum for applications in English/12 pages maximum for applications in French, excluding required attachments, using an 11-point font and maintaining the margins as they appear on the application form.
- Submissions must include all requested information. Incomplete submissions will not be reviewed.

- All documents must be submitted in a single PDF format with a maximum size of 45 MB.
